Course Description:

PowerMill is a standalone CAM program that allows users to create expert NC programs for 3-axis to 5-axis applications. It has become the industry standard for providing the utmost toolpath control, accuracy and efficiency for simple and complex parts.

This training program covers the fundamentals of programming 3-axis machinery using PowerMill. As a prerequisite, students should have a basic understanding of CNC equipment and terminology. Previous CAM experience is a definite asset but is not mandatory.

Upon completion, students will gain confidence in using PowerMill to create safe and efficient toolpaths, employing best practises and leveraging proper workflows from start to finish.
